The following are potential examples of programs that could work for RDMW version of the EcoPrise program that has been developed by the Kitimat-Stikine Regional District.

**Organic Diversion for Livestock Feed**

If a livestock owner were to collect organic food waste for feeding their animals, a subsidy could be paid for the amount of waste diverted from the waste stream.

**Diverting Glass for Aggregate Use**

If a gravel pit owner were to collect glass waste for use as an aggregate, a subsidy could be paid for the amount of waste diverted from the waste stream.

**Deconstruction/Recycling of Used Building Materials**

Businesses that can deconstruct or recycle used building materials could be eligible for a subsidy.

**Recycling of Used Styrofoam Packaging or Hard Back Books for Insulation**

Businesses that can recycle used Styrofoam packaging materials could be eligible for a subsidy.
